Australian Show Rabbit Council Inc., affiliation checklist

On application or renewal of Club affiliation, the Club agrees the below points are included in their show rules or membership requirements and are upheld as an ASRC affiliate Club.

Membership

A member applying is not banned, with any other British Rabbit Council or Australian Show Rabbit Council affiliated Club. It remains the Club's responsibility to verify membership status with other Australian Clubs.

On application for membership, a member waives all right of action against their parent Club, ASRC or officers of said Club's.

ASRC membership

Individual Club members may apply for ASRC membership and prefix registry direct. They must remain a member of an affiliated Club to maintain ASRC membership as well.

As part of an individual Club's affiliation, the nominated Club ASRC representative must remain financial with ASRC.

Prefix

A prefix issued to an ASRC affiliated Club member will be confirmed with ASRC's registrar and duly listed.

Exhibition

Minimum age of exhibition is twelve weeks for a rabbit kitten.

All show rules in regards to reporting of contagious disease must be observed including cancellation of shows in the immediate vicinity of RHDV outbreaks, per ASRC and BRC show rules. Distance from outbreak is updated pending BRC Health & Welfare Committee advice at the time and as minuted by the BRC. Strict quarantine rules apply for members effected by RHDV and its strains and myxomatosis. Vaccination with the available vaccine at the time is expected of all show exhibits in the aim of preventing further spread of these diseases.

Leg Rings

Leg rings are sold for the identification of show rabbits. To maintain the ability to purchase legs rings it is suggested an exhibitor must exhibit a minimum of three times a year to maintain purchase privileges.

In the case of non ARBA breeds being exhibited, per their standard a tattoo is suggested. Tattoos numbers are issued free of charge to ASRC Clubs and are available for all breeds. The suggested price for sale to members is \$1.00

Judging

Judging shows per British Rabbit Council standards, with additional breeds as notified by ASRC.

While it is the judge’s responsibility to keep up to date with show rules and breed standards, the issuing of challenges, awards and colour acceptance in breeds remains the responsibility of the ASRC host Club to advise the judge of the day.

Challenges issued to a kitten (12 - 14 weeks) in an open show may not be included when applying for an ASRC title. Please ensure the age is circled when issuing the cc.

Any Club member may apply to ASRC for championship status, and must include copies of all star graded awards issued. ASRC members will be presented with both a certificate and sash in November of each year. Non ASRC members will be provided with a digital certificate to be issued by their Club.

It is understood on application, the above points, in conjunction with ASRC and the BRC Show Rules Book are upheld when convening a star graded show. While ASRC do not charge for show support nor control star grading’s, it is expected these rules are followed to maintain continuity between Clubs.

Code of conduct and ethics

The issued online code of conduct and ethics covers all who apply and exhibit at ASRC affiliated Clubs, Shows and events. Terms of sale to minor’s minimum kitten sale age apply. It is agreed the Club will educate members and ensure these rules and ethics are upheld at all times.
